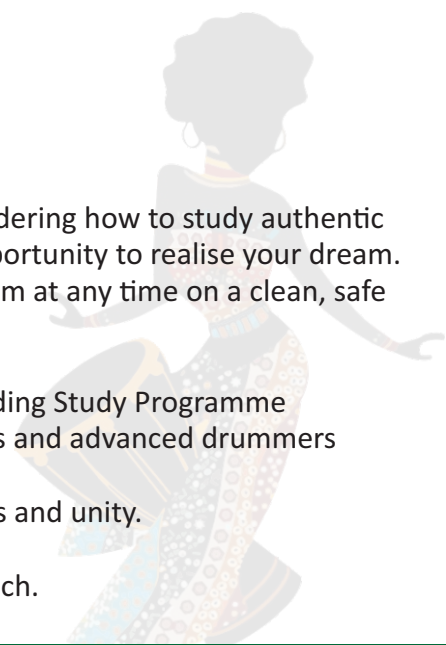
WELCOME TO KLIBOURA AFRICA DRUMMING & DANCE WORKSHOP

Dance & Drumming Workshop

DANCE

With 4 hours of dancing in a day, there is no doubt you will improve your dance ability on this tour. In two daily dance sessions, we will focus on learning the dances that accompany the rhythms taught to the drummers.

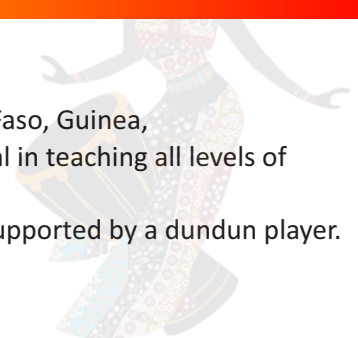
A blend of ancient and contemporary grooves that are part of everyday ceremony and ritual across the musical landscape of West Africa. You will work on gaining form, endurance, and repertoire. Each dance arrangement will be broken down step by step, professionally taking the time for you to master the postures and techniques for each dance for all beginners to advanced. You'll learn about the historical & cultural elements of the traditional dances as our teachers share how they continue to influence contemporary dance. Dance classes are accompanied by live drumming.



DRUMMING

You will learn a package of traditional Djembe, Dundun and Kpanlogo rhythms from Burkina Faso, Guinea, Ivory Coast and Ghana by our team of Master Drummers who are very patient and professional in teaching all levels of drummers (beginners, intermediate and advanced).

Explore the rhythms and songs in two classes a day, led by one of our master drummers and supported by a dundun player. For four hours each day, you will explore the rhythms and songs of a variety of ethnic groups.

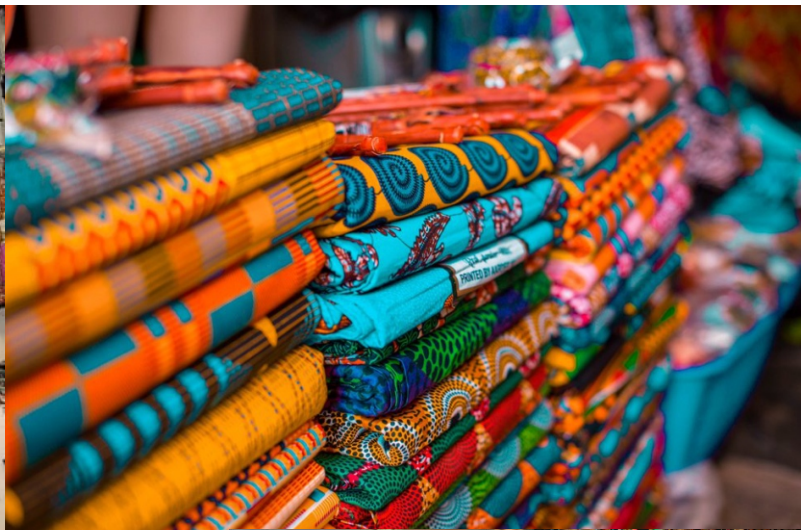




GETTING TO AFRICA

FARES

Tour goers are responsible for booking and paying for their own airfare. Fares vary depending on where you depart from and who you book with. Keep in mind that prices tend to rise towards the end of the year.

Check your local consulate and travel agencies for details and we advise that you book your ticket with the airline you prefer on time to ensure your safety.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Tour goers are responsible for their own travel and medical insurance. We recommend for everyone to take up a policy for peace of mind.

HEALTH CARE

Medicine and vaccines are personal choices as we do not give medical advice. These should be considered in consultation with your travel doctor.

FAQ - IN TRANSIT

What happens when I arrive at the airport in Accra, Ghana?

We will be there to pick you up. Once you've cleared customs, make your way to the outside area at Arrivals. A member of our team will have a board or poster with your name, and references to Kliboura Africa.

Where do our students typically come from?

Mainly Europe especially Germany but we have had people from Australia, Italy, UK, US, Canada, Denmark, Finland, New Zealand, Russia and France. African traditional music and dance knows no borders.

Can I bring a non-drumming friend or family member along with me?

Yes and we will offer special rate which is reasonable to enable everyone closer to you enjoy and have a feel of the odyssey with us. Not the same as the tour rate!

If I have special dietary requirements can the kitchen look after me?

Gluten free, Vegetarian, Vegan & FODMAP diets can be catered for but take our kitchen extra time to source ingredients and prepare meals. As such, an additional charge payable on arrival date.

What access is there to power?

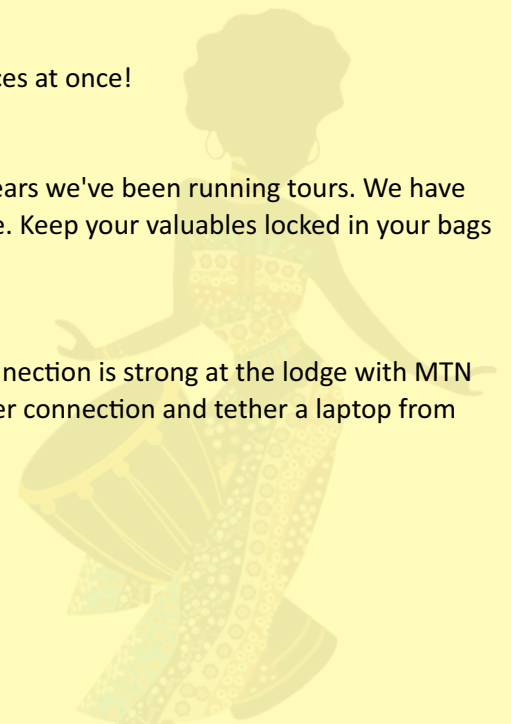
Every room has UK power outlets - bring a power board to charge all your devices at once!

How secure will my valuables be at the lodge?

Is there some way to keep things secure? Nothing has been stolen in the past years we've been running tours. We have a security guards and a very honest family working for us. We do not have a safe. Keep your valuables locked in your bags in your rooms. You're free to lock your door during the day if you like.

Is there Internet?

SIM Cards with data are available everywhere and are really cheap. Internet connection is strong at the lodge with MTN sim card and you can check emails and SM easily enough. You can access a better connection and tether a laptop from your Ghana SIM at really cheap Data rates.





FAQ - ON TOUR

ON TOUR

Is the tour mainly drumming or can I focus on dance? We build and evolve your study program based on what you would like to learn and how you'd like to balance it. Two classes are available in both drum and dance on every weekday. We also add in drum and dance jams each week to unite everyone at the end of the day.

How do I get the instruments, art and craft I buy back home?

It's easy to get excited by things like art, craft and beads and spend up big on tour.

Drums are typically 7kg and by removing the hair you'll have a great chance to get your drum into customs.

Check baggage allowances with your airline before you travel.

Is there anything I can bring for donations that would be useful or valuable?

Stationary for the kids. Two of our members are teachers in a Pre-school so we would help you to get you donations directly to the kids! Educational I.C.T items like (used) laptops, handies, books and CDs of exciting music, footballs, soccer boots and jerseys are always popular.

Will I need a drum on the tour?

Yes - all drummers will need a djembe (or duns) which we have available for purchase or hire.

Do Foreign phones work in Ghana?

Some carriers may have reasonable bundles but rates are expensive for other carriers (like Telstra). You're much better off getting a local SIM card which allows very cheap local and international calls plus very cheap Data packages.

Make sure you UNLOCK your phone before you come to Ghana.

Should I bring Traveller's Cheques, a Visa Card or Cash?

Are there ATMs around?

We recommend bringing US dollars, Euros or British pounds for spending money. We suggest bringing large notes (eg \$50s, €50s and \$100s or €100) as you'll get a better exchange rate. We have a representative who can change money at the lodge in Accra. We generally advise against Travellers Cheques as they are only redeemable at a few banks.

VISA card is accepted at most ATMs, Mastercard at around 40%. An ATM for Visa withdrawals is a 20 - 45 minutes taxi trip away.

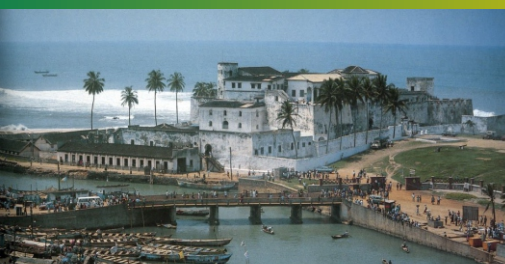
